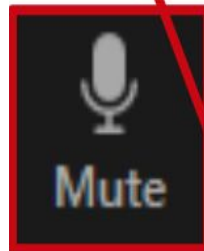
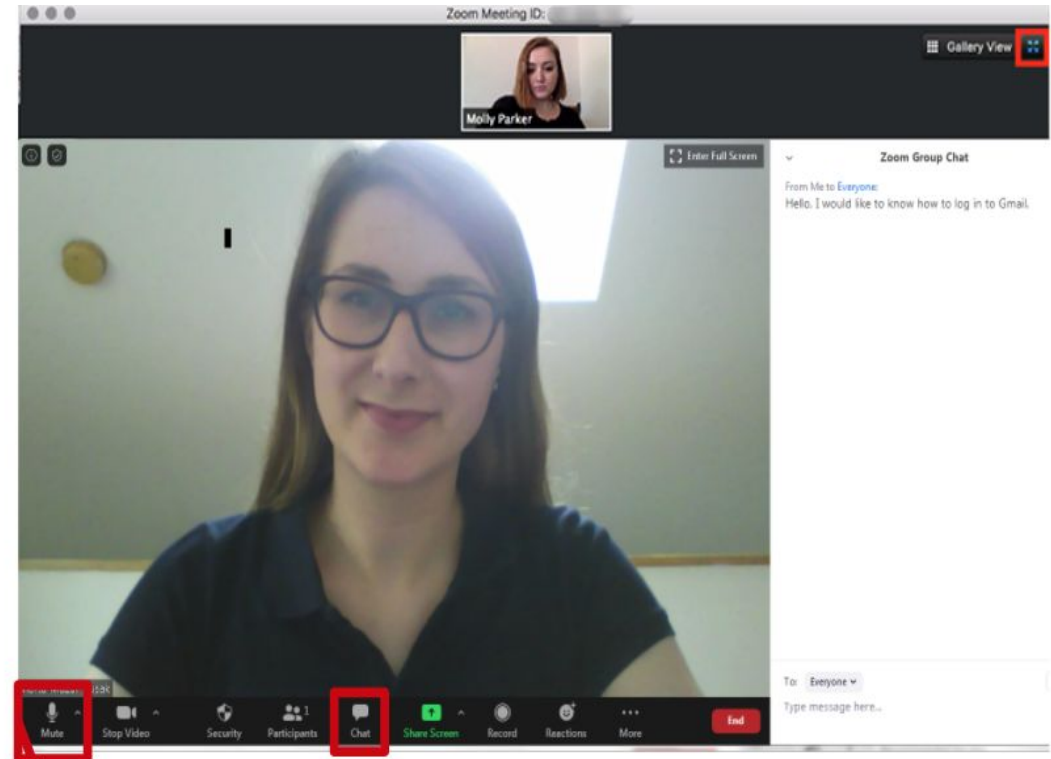

What is Indeed and Why To Use it

The What:

Indeed is a free job listing website where job seekers can upload resumes, cover letters, and other information and easily apply for jobs.

The Why:

- ❑ Most popular job search engine in the US.
- ❑ Free
- ❑ Easily integrated with Google Account

DOWNSIDE: Can be more competitive because it can be easy to apply.

Reminders:

- ❑ Be careful when uploading your resume to Indeed; ensure it is formatted properly and has no errors.
- ❑ Always include a cover letter when applying for a job.
- ❑ Make sure you check your email and indeed messages for any follow-ups.
