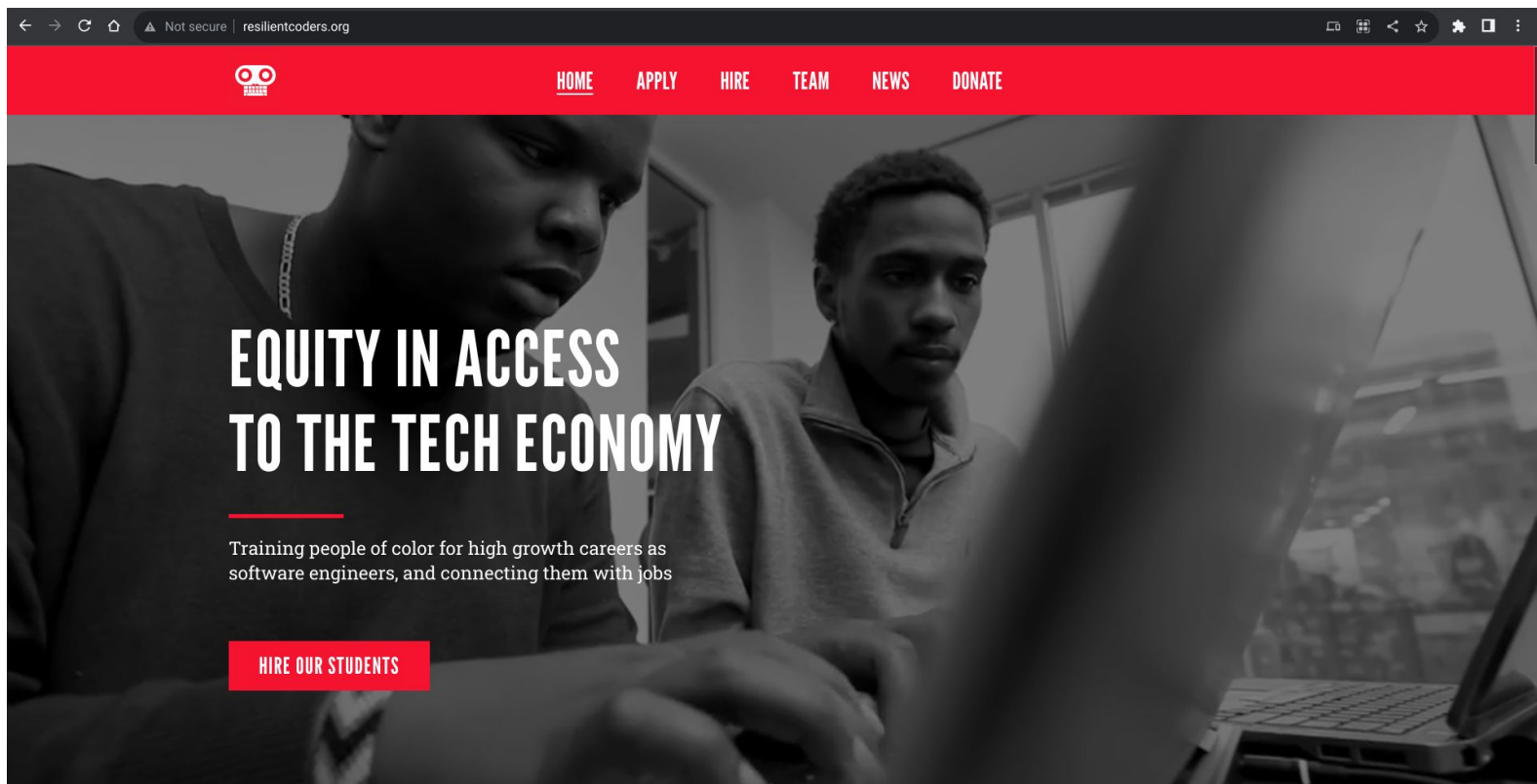
Resilient Coders Application

Description:

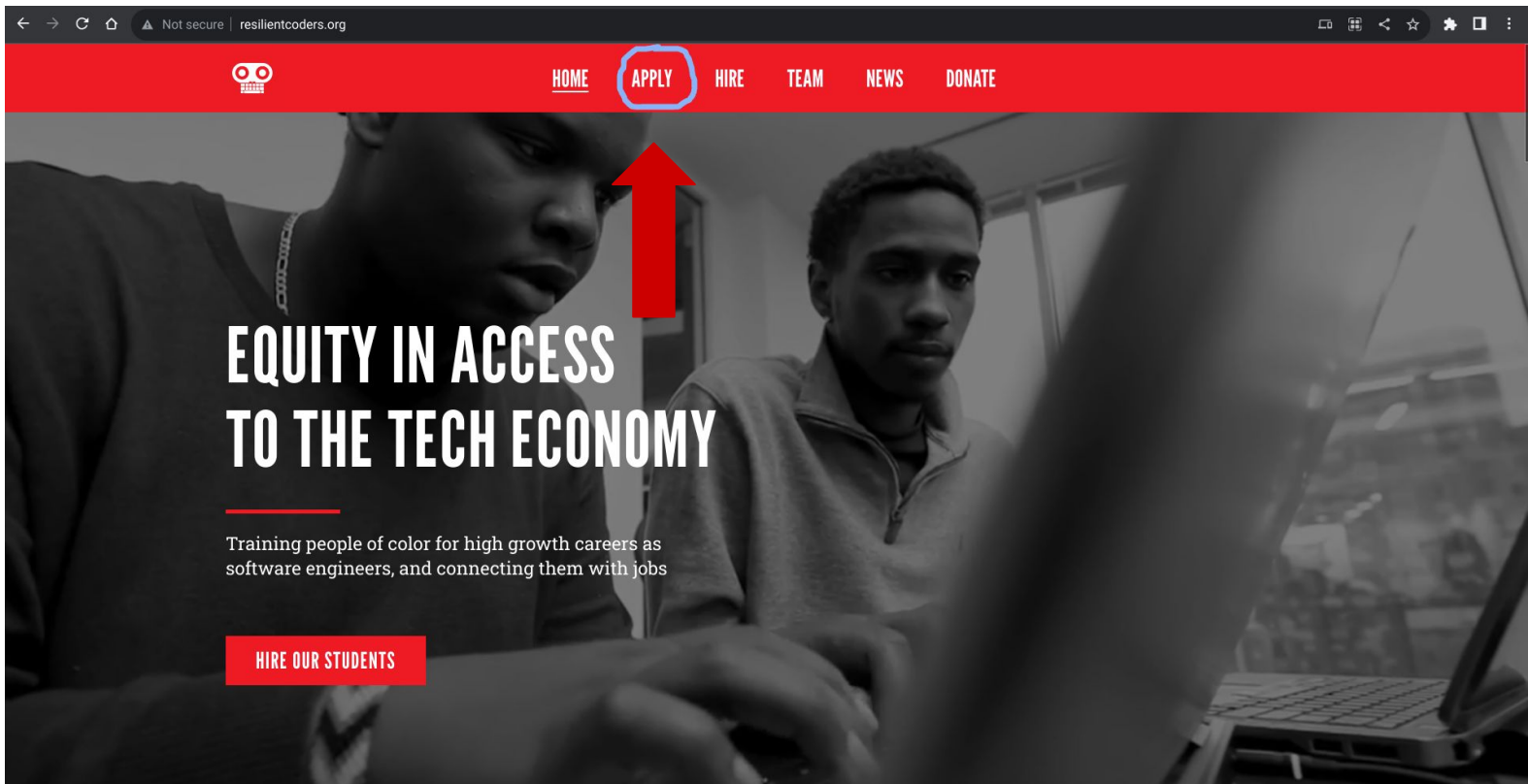
Resilient Coders is an organization dedicated to training people of color for careers as software engineers and connecting them with job. This tutorial will show you how to apply for their coding bootcamp.

Instructions

- A quick thing to note is that applications are at the time of the creation of this tutorial closed and will reopen on Monday October 2nd, 2023
- First, go to the link of the website provided here [Resilient Coders](https://www.resilientcoders.org/) or type in this URL in a new google chrome tab <http://www.resilientcoders.org/>
- You will then be brought to the front page of the website shown below



- At the top of the screen, find the 'Apply' tab(circled in blue below) and click on it



- If you scroll down the page, you will see some information about the bootcamp such as what to expect from the camp and some alumni stories
- Scrolling down further, you will find the Eligibility requirements to be able to attend this bootcamp(shown below). Make sure that you pass all of the given requirements, including the one hour class and responsive design coursework

ELIGIBILITY

As a non-profit organization that provides free training with a learning stipend, we have a mandate to work alongside:

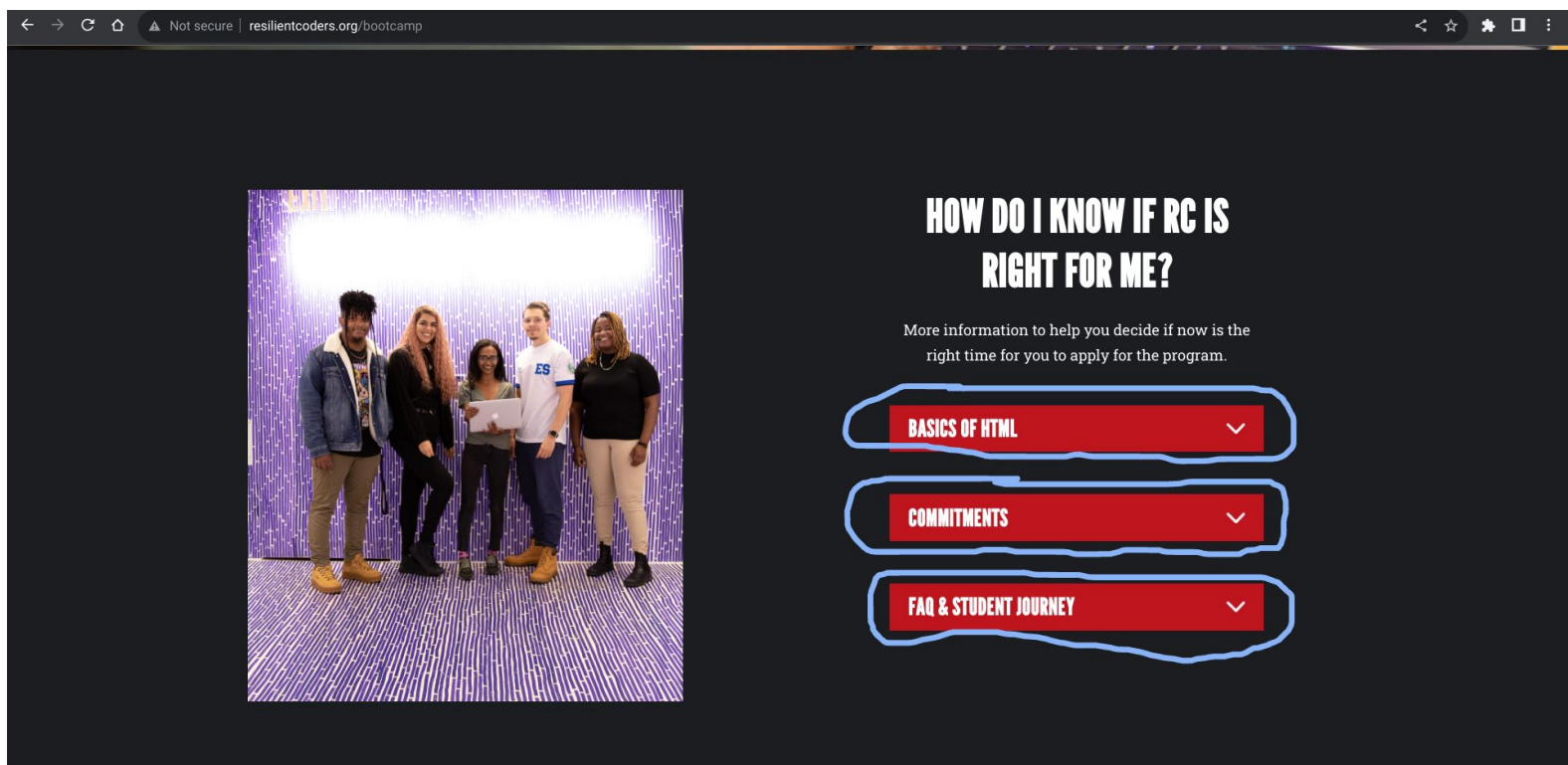
- Black, Indigenous, Latinx, AAPI, or identify as POC
- Between the ages of 18-35
- Residents in the Greater Boston and Greater Philadelphia areas
- You have a low income background. We have a specific racial and socioeconomic mandate
- You are ready and eligible to work in this country
- You can commit to working as a software engineer in the city you applied to immediately following the bootcamp
- High school diploma or equivalency. Please note that our program focuses on people who have limited access to traditional educational pathways. About a quarter of our students have a bachelor's degree, which is roughly consistent proportionally with our minority-majority neighborhoods. Unfortunately, we can't admit candidates with advanced post-secondary degrees (MBA, PhD, etc).

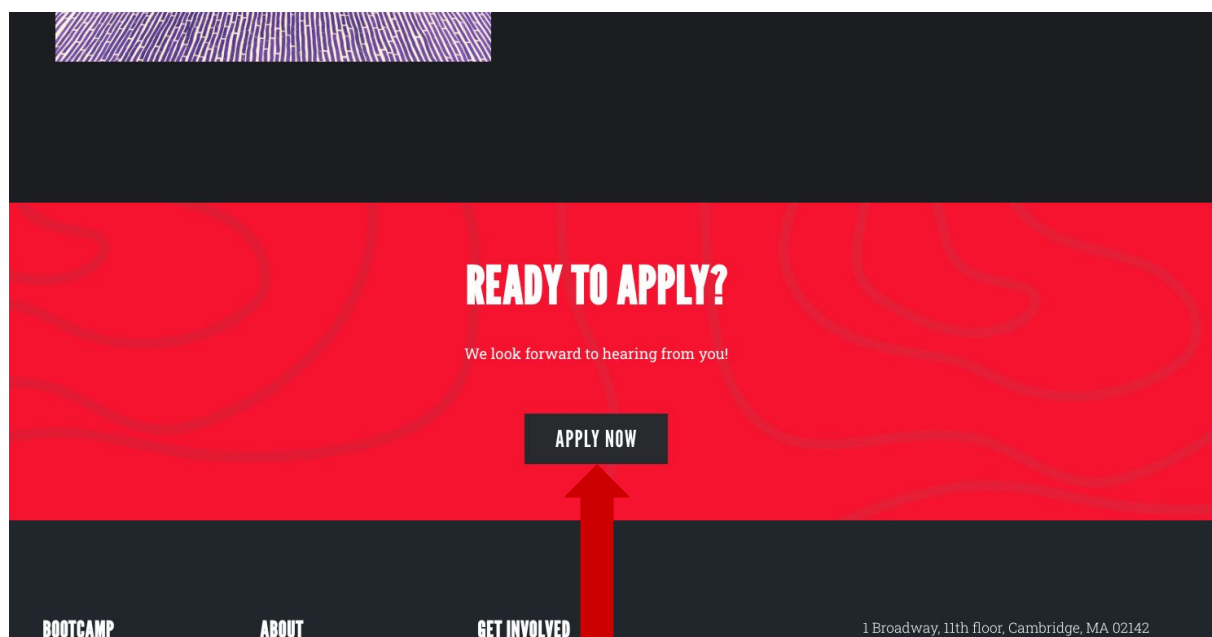
